## How to Assign a Research Coordinator in Mentor IRB


### Who is a Research Coordinator (RC)?

A Research Coordinator (RC) is someone authorized to manage the day-to-day operations of a research study on behalf of the Principal Investigator (PI). In the Mentor IRB system, an RC can:


- Edit IRB protocols
- Submit modifications
- Communicate with the IRB on behalf of the PI

### Step-by-Step: Assigning a Research Coordinator (RC)

- 1. PI or Research Lead Logs into Mentor IRB
  - Only the Principal Investigator (PI) or designated research lead can initiate this process.
- 2. Navigate to Coordinator Assignment
  - Click the IRB tab in the left menu
  - Select Research Coordinators
  - Click Designate a New Research Coordinator



- 3. Search and Select the Person
  - Enter the individual's last name in the search field
  - Select them from the search results
  - Confirm assignment to your lab, center, or research team



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- 4. Assign to Specific Protocol(s)
  - After designation, go to each study where the RC should be involved
  - Submit a minor modification for each protocol to formally add them
    - o Please refer to <u>How to Submit an IRB Modification</u>, <u>Continuing Review</u>, <u>Adverse Event</u>, <u>and Deviation Report</u> within the <u>How to submit->Modifications</u> section of our website for more information.
  - In your modification memo, let the IRB office know if you'd like the RC to be set as the Primary Coordinator.

### What Happens Next?

- The IRB will review each protocol modification to confirm the RC's role
- The RC gains permission to manage IRB activities for the assigned study/studies
- Multiple coordinators can be assigned, but only one can be marked as Primary
